It is hereby ORDERED that this appeal shall be consolidated with CBCA 198-ISDA, CBCA 329-ISDA through CBCA 336-ISDA for all further proceedings.

In addition, this suspension does not prevent either party from filing dispositive motions in the future, and Respondent may file the Answer and the Appeal file during the pendency of the stay without causing the stay to be lifted, or may file the Answer and Appeal file when the stay is lifted.


