ORDER

The above-captioned appeals are currently stayed until July 31, 2007, pending resolution of motions in *Arctic Slope Native Association*, CBCA 190-ISDA and 289-ISDA through 297-ISDA (IBCA 4794-4803-2006), and/or *Metlakatla Indian Community*, CBCA 181, and 279-282-ISDA (IBCA 4857- 4861/2006), and *Confederated Tribes of the Coos, Lower Umpqua and Siuslaw Indians*, CBCA 171 and 235-237-ISDA (IBCA 4724-4727/2005). Those cases have similar legal issues, and motions to dismiss and for summary relief are pending in those cases. It is not anticipated that those motions will be resolved prior to the end of July, 2007, and therefore the stay in the instant cases is extended until October 31, 2007.
