**ORDER GRANTING PRELIMINARY APPROVAL OF

ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED THAT:

1. The Joint Motion for Preliminary Approval of a Second Partial Settlement
Agreement and for Order Authorizing Class Notice dated 9/9/02 is granted.

2. The evidentiary approval hearing to consider final approval of the Second Partial Settlement Agreement will be conducted on Dec 5 2002, at 10⁰⁰, o'clock at the United States Courthouse at 333 Lomas Boulevard, NW, Albuquerque, New Mexico, before the Honorable C. LeRoy Hansen, United States District Judge. Class members who wish to attend or appear at the hearing are advised to confirm the date, time and place of the hearing prior to this date by calling the Clerk of Court.

3. The Settlement Notice shall be published and sent to class members by the means and in the manner set forth in the Second Partial Settlement Agreement.


4. Plaintiffs' counsel may file an application for fees and expenses no later than the date on which they mail the Settlement Notice to the known members of the Class.




