ORDER

THIS MATTER having come before the Court on the parties' Joint Motion to Lift Stay and Set Briefing Schedule, the Court being apprised in the premises,

IT IS HEREBY ORDER, ADJUDGED AND DECREED:

1. The stay of proceedings previously entered on August 13, 2002 (Docket No. 671) is vacated.
2. The parties may file supplemental briefs on their pending cross-motions for summary judgment as follows:
 - a. The Class, as represented by the named class representatives, plaintiffs Ramah Navajo Chapter, Oglala Sioux Tribe and Pueblo of Zuni, may file one opening brief on behalf of the Class no later than seventy-five (75) days after entry of this



b. Defendants may file one opening brief forty-five (45) days after the Class has filed its opening brief. 9/6 x

c. The Class shall file its responsive brief fourteen (14) days after the defendants file their opening brief. 9/20 x

d. The defendants shall file their responsive brief fourteen (14) days after the Class files its responsive brief. 10/4 x

3. No party shall be allowed to file additional briefs in this case in support of or in opposition to the cross-motions for summary judgment without prior approval from the Court.
